

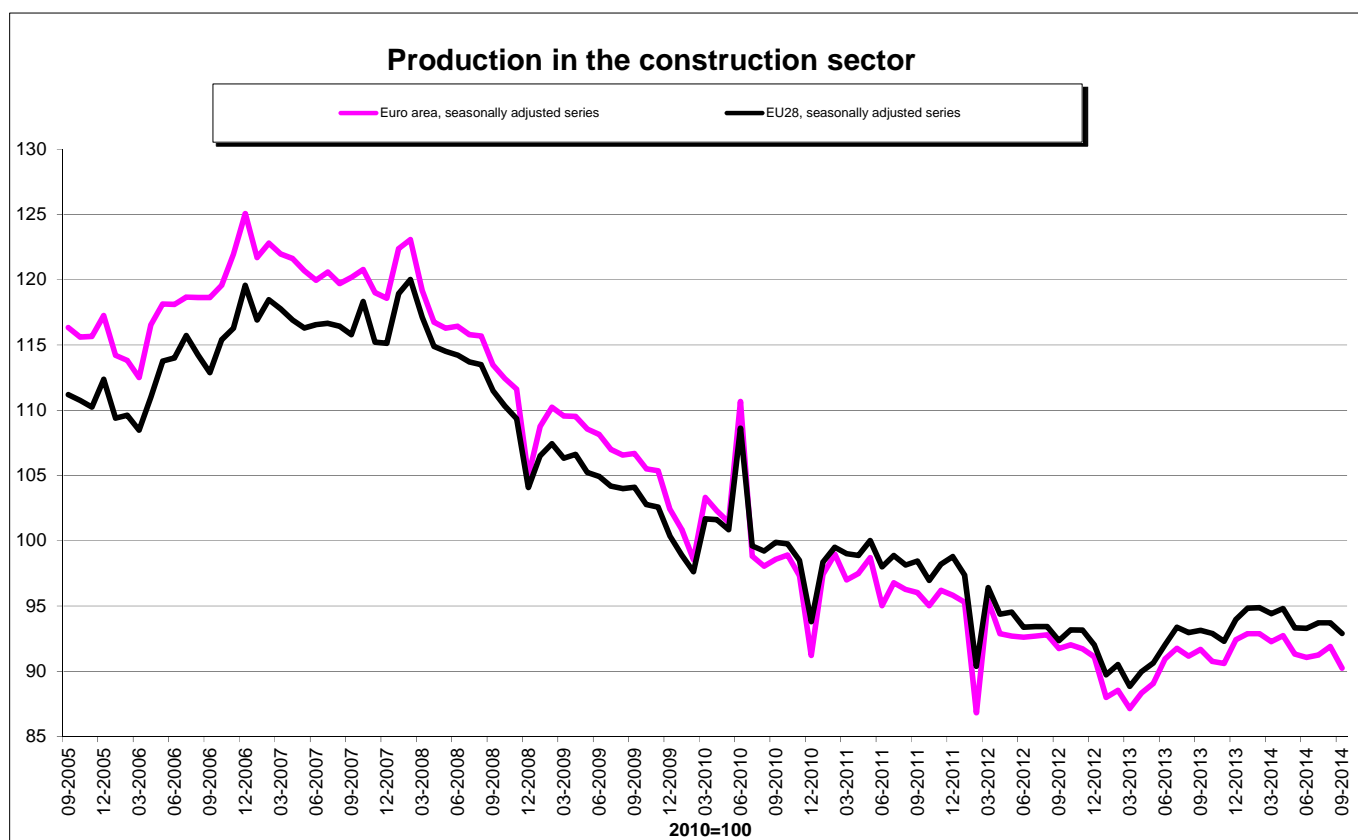

September 2014 compared with August 2014

## Production in construction down by 1.8% in euro area Down by 0.9% in EU28

In September 2014 compared with August 2014, seasonally adjusted production in the construction<sup>1</sup> sector fell by 1.8% in the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA18) and by 0.9% in the **EU28**<sup>2</sup>, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In August 2014<sup>3</sup>, production in construction grew by 0.7% in the **euro area** and remained stable in the **EU28**.

In September 2014 compared with September 2013<sup>4</sup>, production in construction fell by 1.7% in the **euro area** and by 0.4% in the **EU28**.



## Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 1.8% in production in construction in the **euro area** in September 2014, compared with August 2014, is due to building construction falling by 1.6% and civil engineering by 3.0%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 0.9% is due to building construction falling by 0.8% and civil engineering by 1.3%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in production in construction were observed in **Slovenia** (-8.6%), **Italy** (-5.4%), **Sweden** (-3.2%) and **France** (-2.3%), and the highest increases in **Romania** (+7.9%), the **Czech Republic** (+2.7%) and **Bulgaria** (+2.4%).

## Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

The decrease of 1.7% in production in construction in the **euro area** in September 2014, compared with September 2013, is due to building construction falling by 1.2% and civil engineering by 2.1%.

In the **EU28**, the decrease of 0.4% is due to civil engineering falling by 1.9%, while building construction rose by 0.3%.

Among Member States for which data are available, decreases in production in construction were registered in **Italy** (-10.6%), **Portugal** (-5.2%), **France** (-3.4%), the **Netherlands** (-3.1%) and **Germany** (-1.5%), and the highest increases in **Spain** (+9.1%), the **Czech Republic** (+8.2%), **Hungary** (+7.3%), **Slovenia** (+6.2%) and **Bulgaria** (+5.8%).

1. The index of production in construction approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering. Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects. The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.

2. The euro area (EA18) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
The European Union (EU28) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland, Sweden and the United Kingdom.  
The tables also include Norway and Switzerland.
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 156/2014 of 17 October 2014. The monthly growth rates for August 2014 have been revised from +1.5% to +0.7% for the euro area and from +0.5% to 0.0% for the EU28. The annual growth rates have been revised from -0.3% to +1.5% for the euro area and from -0.8% to +0.8% for the EU28.
